GIRLS DOMITORY

The Girls Dormitory at Musoto Christian School is really taking shape. The foundations have been finished, so work has progressed to building the walls, ready for the roof construction that will start in the next few weeks.



HEALTHCARE BUILDING WORK

Work continues at our healthcare sites. A security gatehouse is being built at the clinic and fencing is being put up around the site. At the Maternity Centre, terrazzo flooring has just been laid.

NAMATALA LAND

Geotechnical surveys of the Namatala land - where the new secondary school will be built - have been undertaken in preparation for the construction works that will be commencing soon.



Holes have been dug for the planting of Jacaranda Trees. These trees are very hardy, resistant to pests and diseases and moderately drought-tolerant, making them a good choice for large outdoor areas in warm climates. They will provide plenty of shade for the school children and for much of the time, display a stunning purple flower that will further enhance the beauty of the site.
